

# ASBE AWARDS

## Best Paper Award

This award is presented to the best paper submitted to the annual conference. The award comes with a cash award as well as acceptance for publication in the *Journal of Business and Entrepreneurship*.

If the quality of submissions warrants it, there may also be presentations for runner-up papers.

## Best Student Paper Award

We are also excited to present an award to the best graduate student paper award. This award is given to a student authored paper which is solely written by a graduate student or is listed as first author with no more than one non-student as an author. This award also comes with a cash award and will be considered for publication in the *Journal of Business and Entrepreneurship*.

## Best Workshop Award

This award will be presented for the first time at the 2014 conference. The award will be given for the workshop that makes the biggest impact on the attendees at the conference as judged by a committee appointed by the Board.

## Outstanding Educator Award

This award is presented to that individual that has made a long-term impact on the entrepreneurship discipline through efforts in the classroom, campus, and/or their community.

## University Entrepreneurship Advocacy Award

This award was inaugurated in 2013 and is presented to that University providing the greatest support for entrepreneurship at their institution. This support can include general internal support for the entrepreneurship program, community outreach, or a continued public recognition of the efforts of entrepreneurship at their institution.

## Fellows Award

This award is presented to individuals that have made a long-term impact on ASBE by their efforts of leadership, commitment, and participation in the organization. It represents the highest award given by the organization.

**Note:** Nominations for Outstanding Educator Award and University Entrepreneurship Advocacy Award should be sent to the executive director (William Jackson [wtj@usfsp.edu](mailto:wtj@usfsp.edu)) 30 days prior to the annual conference. Nominations for the Fellows Award are handled separately conducted by the Dean of Fellows and are only voted on by previously selected Fellows. An active officer is not eligible for this award.
